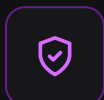

PRIZE MONEY AGREEMENT

Put the prize pool terms in writing. State how much, when it gets paid, and what happens if a player is disqualified. Don't leave this to a verbal promise.

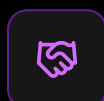

PLAYER WAIVERS & ELIGIBILITY RULES

Get every player to sign a waiver before they compete. Set clear rules on who can join (age, location, account verification) so you're not stuck settling disputes mid tournament.

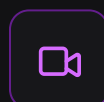

SPONSORSHIP AGREEMENTS

If a brand is putting money or products into your event, get the deal in writing. Cover what they're paying for, what they expect in return, and what happens if either side doesn't deliver.

STREAMING & BROADCAST RIGHTS

Decide upfront who owns the footage and who can stream or clip it. This matters more once your tournament grows and platforms or brands want a piece of the content.

A WAY TO SETTLE DISPUTES

Players will disagree with results at some point. Have a simple process written down for how complaints get raised and resolved, so it doesn't turn into chaos on stream.
